Before you leave home

- #6 Check your airline's website for travel requirements and flight status.
- #7 Print your boarding pass or download your airline's mobile app.
- #8 Pack your face covering, hand sanitizer (up to 12oz) or wipes in your carry-on.
- #9 Pack a snack & per TSA, place in a clear plastic bag.

At the airport

- #10 Wear your face covering throughout your airport journey.
- #11 RNO employees will be wearing face coverings.
- #12 We strongly encourage all tenants to do so as well.
- #13 Pay attention to social distancing and signage.
- #14 RNO is performing continuous, 24/7 cleaning throughout the airport.
- #15 We use CDC approved, hospital grade disinfectant.
- #16 Plexiglas shielding has been installed at key counter areas.
- #17 Restaurants and stores are open post security.
- #18 Airlines have limited/suspended inflight food and beverage services.
- #19 If you didn't pack a snack, food is available at airport restaurants.
- #20 Buy a beverage post security.
